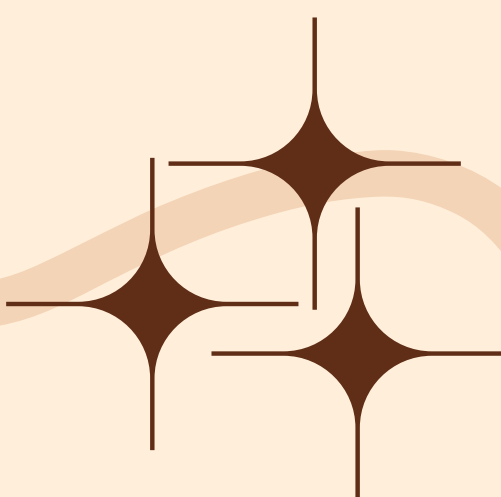




BEST DAD EVER

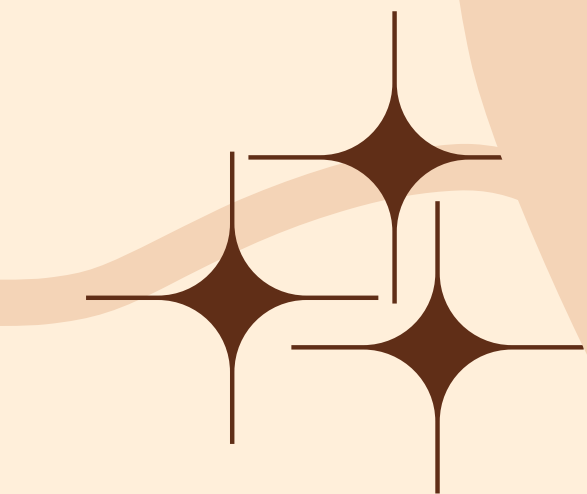
